## Connecting Europe's hydrogen valleys

In Zeebrugge (Belgium), the HyOffwind plant is part of a hydrogen valley that integrates production, transport, storage and use. Across North-West Europe, similar hydrogen valleys have emerged, but they are developing independently, hindering the region's potential to lead the clean hydrogen economy.

ValHyCon connects these valleys into a unified ecosystem, enabling partners to share knowledge and develop a coordinated strategy. Through these efforts, the project accelerates the uptake of hydrogen-based solutions for a cleaner industry and greater EU energy independence.
